A premium touring rally exclusively for sports and prestige cars of all brands. Winding roads in Corsica with stunning landscapes, smooth driving stages with little traffic in Sardinia that will "awaken" your passion for driving, combined with stays in 4 & 5-star hotels. This is the program for this Premium Rally in the Mediterranean!

Stages:

Tuesday, September 16: Ferry Toulon / Porto Torres.

Board the ferry in Toulon in the evening at 6:00 PM heading to Porto Torres. Dinner on board, briefing, and overnight in your private cabin with en-suite facilities.

Wednesday, September 17: Porto Torres / Porto Cervo, 5 hours of driving.

We will disembark at around 8:00 AM in Porto Torres and take the scenic route to Castelsardo, a picturesque village perched on a rocky promontory overlooking the sea. We continue towards Nuoro, the cultural heart of Sardinia, to explore its quaint streets and authentic atmosphere. Then, we descend to Su Gologne for a break amidst the mountains and natural springs. We end our day arriving at Porto Cervo, where you will spend the night in an elegant setting in the heart of Costa Smeralda.

Thursday, September 18: Free Day

You are in the heart of Costa Smeralda, the playground of the international Jet Set, with no shortage of visits and activities for this free day. Discover the Maddalena archipelago with its turquoise waters 40 km away, go shopping in Porto Cervo, play golf at the magnificent Pevero course, etc. Or simply relax at the hotel, enjoying a day of leisure with beach, pool, spa, or massages—it's up to you ! Optional activity : head to the Autodromo di Mores for a circuit experience in Sardinia (additional cost).

Friday, September 19: Porto Cervo / Bonifacio / Olmeto, 4 hours 30 minutes of driving.

We leave Porto Cervo and follow the coastal route to Santa Teresa di Gallura to board the ferry to Bonifacio, where you will discover the beauty of the white cliffs. Once in Corsica, we head to Sotta for a typical lunch in a peaceful setting. Then, we cross the Col Saint Eustache, offering exceptional panoramic views, before stopping for a coffee in the charming village of Petreto. We continue to the Marinca hotel in Olmeto, a haven of peace overlooking the sea, for a night of relaxation and comfort.

Saturday, September 20: Olmeto / Calvi, 4 hours 50 minutes of driving.

Starting from Olmeto, we quickly reach Propriano and follow the coast to Cargèse, enjoying breathtaking views of beaches and wild coves. We then head towards the Calanques de Piana, a must-see with its spectacular red rock formations, before descending to Porto for a break by the sea. We continue along the scenic route through the Scandola Reserve to Galéria, where nature reveals itself in all its splendor. We end our journey by crossing the Balagne to Calvi, famous for its picturesque port and majestic citadel, where we will spend the night.

Sunday, September 21: Calvi / Saint Florent / Bastia, 4 hours 40 minutes of driving.

We depart from Calvi heading to Bravone Beach for a lunch break, taking the coastal road through L'Île Rousse and crossing the beautiful landscapes of the Balagne. After lunch by the sea, we continue through the inland roads to Saint-Florent, passing through Corte, to discover the region's wild mountains and valleys. From Saint-Florent, we cross the Agriates Desert to reach Bastia along the northern coast. Upon arrival in Bastia, we can enjoy one last stroll through the old town before boarding the ferry.

Monday, September 22: Marseille.

Arrival in Marseille at 7:00 AM. After breakfast on board, you will continue your journey to your next destination.

Terms and Conditions for Travel Organization and Sales Activities

The activities related to the organization and sale of trips or tours are governed by law no. 92-645 of July 13, 1992 (J.O. 14.07.92) and its implementing decree no. 94-490 of June 15, 1994 (J.O. 17.06.94) and apply to the proposed trip. Any registration implies acceptance of these general terms and conditions of sale.

1. REGISTRATION

To participate in the proposed trip, the registration form must be returned signed along with a 40% deposit. The balance must be paid 45 days before departure. If the balance has not been paid by this date, the registration will be considered canceled and the client will be subject to the cancellation fees mentioned in section 4 of these conditions.

2. PRICES

Our prices are based on departure from and return to Marseille. They include the services listed under the "Included Services" section.

3. CANCELLATION / MODIFICATION BY THE ORGANIZER

TWINTOUR reserves the right to cancel the trip 45 days before departure due to unforeseen circumstances. Whenever possible, an alternative departure date will be offered to the participant. If the participant cannot accept the modification, the amounts paid will be fully refunded. TWINTOUR reserves the right to modify the itinerary or departure dates if required by unforeseen events. If weather conditions during the trip prevent the planned stages or require additional overnight stays, the client agrees to cover these extra costs for the duration concerned.

4. CANCELLATION BY THE CLIENT

In accordance with Article L.221-28-12 of the French Consumer Code, the right of withdrawal cannot be exercised for tour packages purchased remotely. In the event of cancellation, the client must inform TWINTOUR of their decision by mail. The following cancellation fees apply based on the cancellation date (postmark as proof):

- More than 60 days before departure: 20% of the total amount
- From 59 to 40 days before departure: 40% of the total amount
- From 39 to 20 days before departure: 60% of the total amount
- From 19 to 10 days before departure: 80% of the total amount
- Less than 10 days before departure: 100% of the total amount

5. TRANSFER OF A CONTRACT

The participant may transfer their contract to another person no later than 10 days before the start of the trip, provided the new participant meets all requirements for the trip and has signed these conditions, subject to ferry or flight tickets being transferable. This transfer will incur a fixed fee of \leq 90, in addition to any price adjustments based on the current service costs at the time of modification. The original and new participants will be jointly responsible for paying the remaining balance.

6. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

TWINTOUR is not responsible for:

- Maritime and air transport: A ferry or airline may change the departure date or time due to strikes, overbooking, technical issues, safety concerns, or weather conditions (e.g., storms, bad weather, volcanic eruptions, cyclones). In such cases, TWINTOUR cannot be held liable, and no compensation will be provided, even if this results in a delay or alteration of the planned itinerary.

- Misconduct or illegal actions of hoteliers, service providers, or their staff, causing harm to participants or their belongings.

- Force majeure: In case of interruption or cancellation due to war, uprisings, natural disasters, epidemics, fuel shortages, or other similar events, TWINTOUR will not bear the associated costs.

- Quality of accommodation: TWINTOUR cannot be held liable if the client deems the accommodation unsatisfactory.

- Loss, theft, or personal injury during the trip. The participant agrees to waive any civil or criminal proceedings against TWINTOUR.

- Road accidents or incidents caused by external factors (weather, poor road conditions, stray animals, natural disasters).

- Unpaid extras or damages caused by participants during the trip, as well as any fines incurred, which are the sole responsibility of the participant.

7. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTICIPANT

The participant is entirely responsible for their safety and that of their companions. The participant must comply with the laws and regulations of the countries visited. In the event of violation (e.g., not wearing a helmet, possession or transportation of illegal substances, exceeding legal blood alcohol levels), they will be solely responsible. They must respect speed limits and safety rules in each country. They must be experienced in driving and able to handle extended periods of driving. The participant agrees to return their vehicle to its home address, and Twintour is not responsible for the vehicle's return. The participant must present a car in perfect working order, especially concerning tires and brakes. In case of a breakdown or accident, the participant must manage the issue with their own insurance, as Twintour does not provide mechanical assistance.

If the participant takes risks deemed dangerous by the organizer or shows disrespect towards others, Twintour reserves the right to exclude them without compensation.

8. INSURANCE

Twintour offers participants who register more than 30 days before departure the option to subscribe to AXA group insurance to cover cancellation risks until the day of departure. Vehicle repatriation must be covered by the participant's own insurer. This insurance is available to individuals residing in mainland France, bordering European countries, or Switzerland, for 5% of the trip cost. Coverage details will be provided along with your travel documents.

9. COMPLAINTS

All complaints must be made by registered mail within 15 days after the trip, accompanied by the incident report provided by the local service provider. Complaints submitted by fax, phone, email, or other means, or those submitted outside this timeframe, will not be considered.

10. ADMINISTRATIVE FORMALITIES

Participants must have the following documents during the trip:

- A valid driving license
- A valid ID or passport for the countries visited
- Vehicle registration certificate, and if not the owner, a signed authorization from the owner
- Insurance certificate (green card) covering the visited countries

- If the trip is not paid entirely by a high-end credit card that includes medical repatriation, the participant must ensure their insurance covers this.

11. MISCELLANEOUS

Stages may be modified for imperative reasons or if a provider cancels or changes the scheduled services. Regarding image rights, registration for the rally implies acceptance that images of drivers, co-drivers, and vehicles may be used and exploited by the organization in any form and on any media.
